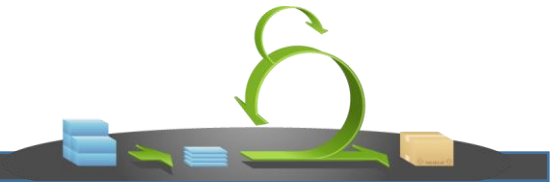
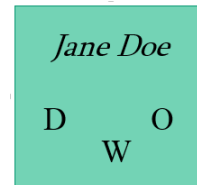


Software Engineering Team Formation Process



1. Each of you will be handed a post-it note. On the top write your name.
2. On the bottom you will write a capital letter representing the skills you would bring to the team
 - a. D is for strong database skills
 - b. O is for strong organizational skills
 - c. E is for extreme programming
 - d. C is for strong communication skills
 - e. W is for strong web development skills
3. Place your post-it note on the Skills Board.
4. I will select five people to start the team forming process. The others will wait outside.
5. We will have rounds for each skill, where these five people will select a team mate who has the first skill.
6. After selection, these five individuals will collect their new team mate from the hall. The new team mate will then select for the second skill, and so on...



Notes:

No stigma! This is not a pickup round for a baseball team. Being selected in the last round means that you were chosen specifically for the skill of round 5.

If there aren't enough skills to go around, teams will have to make do.
